




#### Ride regular route buses too!!



The pass may be used to ride ordinary route buses within the area on the map.


\* The pass can also be used at bus stops serving Fukuoka Airport (Domestic Terminal, International Terminal, and Fukuokakuko-mae).

  - \*Preparations cannot be made immediately before departure.
- It is not a device performing translation/interpretation of the information provided by the Japanese guide.
- This is a service that provides voice guidance automatically when near tourist locations. (1)
- Due to the limited number of devices, you may be asked to share headphones with those seated near you.
- Voice guidance is prepared at your seat.
- Tourists are asked not to operate the guide device manually.
- If voice guidance is not provided as expected in tourist spots, or other malfunctions occur, please raise your hand to alert the bus announcer.

- Bringing pets onboard the bus
- Eating, drinking, or smoking

- \* Please refrain from bringing alcohol onboard
- Putting your hands or face outside the bus

- We reserve the right to suspend or cancel tours due to circumstances that may compromise safety, such as stormy weather or the issuance of an official storm advisory or alert.
- Traffic restrictions due to public events, etc., may cause changes in the route or suspension of the tour.
- On rainy days we will hand out rain ponchos.
- There are no toilets on the bus nor toilet stops along the way.
- Please follow the instructions of bus staff at all times.
- Your clothing may get wet or dirty from rain, tree sap, or bird droppings, etc.

- Please take care of belongings, such as hats and scarves, so that they do not blow away.
- Be careful when climbing or descending the steps of the bus. The steps are slippery when wet.
- Guests are responsible for their own protection from the weather to prevent sunburn, heat exhaustion, or chills.
